NOTABLE CASES

Crime

Serious Violence

- R v JB, CB & MS (2024): Led Junior for the prosecution, prosecuting three defendants alleged to have attempted to murder a member of a rival Organised Crime Group using a firearm.
- R v JG & KG (2025): Led Junior for the prosecution in a case involving the attempted murder of male following the discharge of a firearm in Liverpool. Both Defendants were convicted after trial.

Drugs and Weapons Offences

- Op. Whisperously (2024): instructed to represent a defendant part of an enterprise to import 314kg of Class A drugs into the UK.
- Op. Devour: Led Junior in a 25-handed conspiracy to supply Class A drugs.
- Op. Rhino (2025): Junior Alone representing the Prosecution in a 5-handed conspiracy to produce and supply 70kg of Class B drugs.
- Op. Havoc (2025): Led Junior in a conspiracy to supply Class A and B drugs and for possession of a firearm with intent to cause fear of violence.
- Op. Tumbler: currently Led Junior in a 26-handed conspiracy to supply Class A drugs.
